Supermodels to return in 2012

THE winner of this year's World Supermodels pageant will walk away with \$10,000 when the crowning takes place at Amanuca Island Resort and Spa this afternoon.

And as the 18 supermodels anticipate the crowning moment, the organisers have already decided Fiji will again host next year's event.

This was confirmed by Gavin Dooley, the founder and chief executive officer of the competition.

He said his crew, along with the judges, had already decided on next year's venue.

Mr Dooley said the winner would also be invited to next year's event.

He said the models met locals during their tour of Anuya Village in the Mamanuca Group before visiting Monuriki Island.

"The models were amazed by the village experience and also had a chance to meet school students," said Mr Dooley.

Today's crowning takes place at 2pm.
